What is a research study?

A research study is a study that uses scientific tools to investigate topics such as health or disease.

Research studies include only people who choose to take part. Participation in research may involve a loss of privacy, but information about you will be handled as confidentially as possible.

What is the purpose of this study?

This research study seeks to develop a community-based intervention that increases basic knowledge of hereditary cancer risk genetic testing among Black and African American men.

What is involved?

- Complete a Baseline Survey
- Complete a Follow-up or Exit Survey
- OPTIONAL: If you are interested, you may take a genetic test at NO cost to you



Am I eligible?

To participate in this study, you must:

- 1) Be age 18 or older
- 2) Have prostate cancer
- 3) Have not had a germline genetic test in the past or carry known cancer risk genetic mutation
